

# 金融学

## 一、培养目标

本专业旨在培养适应开放经济环境，具备扎实的政治经济学、金融学、应用数学基础和较强的计算机应用能力与良好的外语水平，系统掌握金融学基本理论与方法，熟练掌握金融分析、金融业务操作技能、风险管理、金融企业经营管理专业知识与基本技能，具有良好的文化道德修养、业务能力和社会责任，具有较强的实践创新和适应能力，能在金融机构、工商企业、事业单位、政府部门从事经济管理工作的复合型、应用型专门人才。

## 二、基本规格要求

本专业学生要求具备以下核心能力：宏观经济分析能力；金融业务管理能力；金融风险管理能力；资产定价分析能力；管理资产价值能力；科学研究能力；继续深造的综合素质；健康全面的人文素养。

## 三、培养特色

经济、金融基础理论扎实，视野开阔，具有系统、创新思维和研究创新能力，实践动手能力强、发展潜力大。

## 四、学制、毕业基本要求及学位授予

1. 本科基本学制 4 年，弹性学习年限 3—6 年，按照学分管理制度管理。

# Finance

## I . Objectives

The educational objectives of this undergraduate program are to help students to develop a profound knowledge of economics, finance, applied mathematics, computer applications, and a good command of a foreign language in the environment of open economy. Students will be provided with basic theories and methods of financial analysis, a range of skills of financial transaction, risk control, and business management of financial enterprises, and they will achieve some qualities related to cultural and moral cultivation, professional capabilities, and social responsibilities. Graduates will be prepared for diverse career paths such as competent managers and researchers in association with business management in financial institutions, business enterprises, public sectors, and government, as well as other related fields.

## II . Basic Requirements

Upon graduation, students will be able to demonstrate: an ability of analyzing macro-economy; a skill of managing financial transactions; an ability of managing financial risks; a capacity of analyzing asset pricing; a skill of managing assets value; an ability of conducting scientific researches; a comprehensive capability of further self-development; sound humanistic qualities.

## III . Characteristics

All students will be equipped with solid background in fundamental theories in both economics and finance, with broad horizon towards the whole society, systematic abilities of creative thoughts and innovative researches, powerful practical capabilities and great potential of further development.

## IV . Program Structure, Graduation Regulations and Admission to the Degree

1. The standard duration of the program is 4-year with flexible 3—6 academic years to complete the curriculum.

2. The program comprises a minimum of 160 credits as following:
