

# 政治学与行政学

## 一、培养目标

本专业旨在培养具有良好人文社会科学素养，系统掌握政治学科的基础知识、基本理论、基本技能与基本方法，可以在党政机关、企事业单位、学术机构和社会组织从事政治活动和公共管理等工作的专业人才，为日后逐渐成长为国家的政治精英、管理精英或学术精英奠定良好的基础。

## 二、基本规格要求

本专业学生基本素质和基本能力要求：

1. 自主学习能力；
2. 观察、分析、解决公共问题的能力；
3. 初步的学术研究能力；
4. 政治参与的能力；
5. 运用外语进行写作和交流的能力。

## 三、培养特色

1. 厚基础。实行宽口径课程结构，建立通识教育课程平台，实行学门、学类、专业核心课程的梯次结构，同时鼓励跨院系选修课程，让学生系统掌握本专业最基本的概念、理论、方法，具备厚实的专业基础，同时具备较宽的专业知识面。

2. 宽口径。基于政治学专业跨学科性、综合性的特点，使学生掌握和运用政治学、行政学、法学、经济学和社会学等相关学科的知识和方法，具有复合型的知识和能力结构，适应社会多元化的需求。

3. 重能力。强调实践能力和创新能力的培养，通过强化实践教学环节和实习基地建设，培养学生运用学科知识解决实际问题能力，掌握运用科学方法分析问题的研究能力，运用专业技能进行组织策划、沟通表达、办公应用等处理公共事务的能力。

4. 广视野。立足中国国情，同时注重拓宽学生的国际视野，注重外语课程设置，实施与国外大学交换培养模式，扩大国际学术交流，提高学生来源的多样化和国际化程度，让学生了解国外政治学学习和研究的前沿信息与经验，实现政治学学科学习国际化与本土化的统一。

## 四、学制、毕业基本要求及学位授予

1. 本科基本学制 4 年，弹性学习年限 3—6 年，按照学分制度管理。

2. 政治学与行政学专业学生毕业最低学分数为 155 学分，其中各类别课程及环节要求学分数如下表：

3. 学生修满培养方案规定的必修课、选修课及有关环节要求学分，达到规定的最低毕业学分数，并修完规定必修但不记学分的所有课程和环节，德、智、体合格，即可毕业。满足学位授予相关文件要求，授予法学学士学位。

4. 学生所得创新学分（按《法学院创新与课外实践奖励学分认定范围和标准》执行）不计入总学分。

# Political and Administrative Science

## I . Educational objectives

This program aims to provide students with quality education in Humanities and the Social Sciences through a systematic grasp of basic knowledge, theories, skills, and methods related to the field of politics. Students will also participate in political and public management activities in the Communist Party of China (CPC) and government organizations, business enterprises and institutions, academic institutions, and social organizations. This program will lay a good foundation for students to become esteemed government officials, business managers, or academics in the future.

## II . Basic requirements

Students under this specialization should possess the following core abilities:

1. Self Learning ability;
2. Ability to observe, analyze, and solve public problems;
3. Ability to conduct academic research;
4. Ability to participate in politics;
5. Ability to communicate and write in a foreign language.

## III . Training features

1. Good foundation; Through a comprehensive course structure, a general education curriculum platform will be built to implement a course with a discipline-category-specialization echelon structure. Students will be encouraged to take courses from other colleges. They will be enabled to grasp basic concepts, theories, and methods systematically, and consequently, establish a strong professional foundation and extensive professional knowledge.

2. Extensive knowledge; Based on the interdisciplinary and comprehensive properties of politics, students will be able to grasp and apply knowledge and methods of politics, administration, law, economics, sociology, and other disciplines. Moreover, they will have the opportunity to gain complex knowledge and abilities that will satisfy the diverse and multi-level requirements of the public.

3. Strong ability; Training will focus on the practical and innovative abilities of students. Students will be trained to solve practical problems by applying their knowledge and academic research ability to analyze problems using the scientific research method. Their administrative ability to organize, plan, communicate, and manage will also be developed. These abilities enhance the relationship between practical teaching and political practice.

4. Broad vision; Based on the actual situation in China, the international perspective of students should be broadened. Accordingly, foreign language courses should be offered, the exchange training model with overseas universities should be implemented, and international academic relationship should be expanded. Through such programs, the diversity and internationalization of student sources will be increased, thus enabling them to obtain internationally advanced information and experience in foreign politics. Consequently, they will obtain a unified knowledge of the internationalization and lo-

calization of political science.

#### IV. Length of schooling, basic requirements for graduation and degrees conferred

1. Basic length of schooling: 4 years. Flexible learning period: 3 to 6 years, according to the credit management system

2. Minimum credits: 155. The credits for various courses are listed in the following table:

3. Students must attend a certain number of compulsory and optional courses, as well as undergo the related links required in the training program to attain the minimum number of graduate credits. They should also attend all compulsory courses and links without credit. Students will graduate with qualifications in moral education, intellectual education, and physical training. A bachelor's degree in law will be conferred to students who qualified.

4. According to the Scope and Standard of the Recognition of the Innovation and Practice of Law College, innovation credits shall not be included in the minimum graduation requirements, that is, the credit of any course and the link required as a graduation standard cannot be used to offset the credits of other courses and links.

#### V. Curriculum and credit distribution

1. General Education Courses [required 27 + (6) + elective 8 credits]

The general education courses consist of required courses and elective courses. General education electives are designed according to the *Curriculum Design of General Education Electives of Hunan University*. Required general education courses are illustrated in the following table.
