

# 法 学

## 一、培养目标

本专业以中国特色社会主义的法治理念为导向,旨在培养具有良好的人文精神和法律素养,掌握系统扎实的法学基础知识、基本理论、基本技能和基本方法,在党政机关、企事业单位、学术机构和社会组织从事法律工作的专门人才,为日后成为党政领导、公务员、法律职业精英、法学学术精英奠定良好的基础。

## 二、基本规格要求

本专业学生应获得以下几方面的核心能力:

1. 学习能力;
2. 学术研究能力;
3. 口头表达能力与法庭辩论技能;
4. 法律文书写作能力;
5. 运用一门外语进行写作和交流的能力;
6. 运用法律知识解决社会实践问题的能力;
7. 社会沟通与交往能力。

## 三、培养特色

本专业以培养“厚基础、宽口径、重能力、国际化”为基本特色。

“厚基础”,通过优化课程结构,在课程中建立通识教育课程平台,实行学门、学类、专业核心课程的梯次结构,广泛、系统、深入地学习人文社科课程与法学专业课程,让学生系统掌握本专业最基本的概念、理论、方法,具备厚实的专业基础。

“宽口径”,基于法学专业跨学科性、综合性的特点,使学生掌握和运用社会学、经济学等其他学科的知识和方法,拓宽知识视野,具有复合型的知识和能力结构,适应社会多元化需求。

“重能力”,强调实践能力和创新能力的培养,通过强化实践教学环节的模拟法庭与法律诊所以及法学实习基地等平台建设,培养学生运用法学知识解决实际问题的实务操作能力,运用科学研究方法收集分析资料的学术研究能力。

“国际化”,基于中国问题立场,在扎实掌握我国法学理论知识的基础上,同时又注重拓宽学生的国际视野,开设法学专业双语课程设置,扩大国际学术交流,实施与境外大学交换培养模式,让学生了解外国和国际法律知识,使学生具有国际化与多元化的法学理论知识。

## 四、学制、毕业基本要求及学位授予

1. 本科基本学制 4 年,弹性学习年限 3—6 年,按照学分制度管理。
2. 法学专业学生毕业最低学分数为 160 学分,其中各类别课程及环节要求学分数如下表:

# Science of Law

## I . Educational objectives

Adopting the concept of a legal system in the Chinese context, this specialization aims to train students to enhance their humanistic spirit and legal literacy as well as to grasp systematic and basic knowledge, theories, skills, and methods related to law. Students will also have the opportunity to practice law in the Communist Party of China (CPC) and government organizations, business enterprises and institutions, academic institutions, and social organizations. This program will lay a good foundation for students to become future CPC and government leaders, civil servants, as well as esteemed legal professionals and academics.

## II . Basic requirements

Students under this specialization should possess the following core abilities:

1. Ability to learn;
2. Ability to conduct academic research;
3. Verbal ability and ability to debate in court;
4. Ability to write legal documents;
5. Ability to communicate and write in a foreign language;
6. Ability to solve social problems using legal knowledge;
7. Social communication ability.

## III . Training features

The basic training features of this program are good foundation, extensive knowledge, strong ability, and internationalization.

**Good foundation:** By optimizing the course structure, a general education curriculum platform will be built to create a course with a discipline-category-specialization echelon structure. Students will be able to learn Humanities, Social Sciences, and Legal courses systematically and comprehensively by grasping basic concepts, theories, and methods, and thus, building a strong professional foundation.

**Extensive knowledge:** Through the interdisciplinary and comprehensive properties of the science of law, students will be able to grasp and apply knowledge and methods of sociology, economics, and other disciplines. The vision and knowledge of students are broadened, providing them with a complex knowledge structure that can satisfy the diverse and multi-level requirements of the public.

**Strong ability:** Training should focus on the practical and innovative abilities of students. Students will be trained to improve their practical operation ability to solve practical problems using legal knowledge, as well as their academic research ability to collect and analyze relevant materials by applying the scientific research method. Simulated courts, legal clinics, and other platforms will be enhanced to link practical teaching with legal practice.

**Internationalization:** Based on the current problems in China, students should master the legal theory of our country, as well as broadening their international perspective. These objectives can be

realized by teaching bilingual law courses, enhancing international academic communication, and conducting exchange training with overseas universities to orient students on foreign and international legal knowledge and international and diverse legal theories.

#### IV. Length of schooling, basic requirements for graduation and degrees conferred

1. Basic length of schooling: Four years. Flexible learning period: 3 to 6 years, according to the credit management system

2. Minimum credits: 160. The credits for various courses are listed in the following table:

3. Students must attend a certain number of compulsory and optional courses, as well as undergo the related links required in the training program to attain the minimum number of graduate credits. They should also attend all compulsory courses and links without credit. Students will graduate with qualifications in moral education, intellectual education, and physical training. A bachelor's degree in law will be conferred to students who qualified.

4. According to the "Scope and Standard of the Recognition of the Innovation and Practice of Law College", innovation credits shall not be included in the minimum graduation requirements, that is, the credit of any course and the link required as a graduation standard cannot be used to offset the credits of other courses and links.

#### V. Curriculum and credit distribution

1. General Education Courses [required 27 + (6) + elective 8 credits]

The general education courses consist of required courses and elective courses. General education electives are designed according to the *Curriculum Design of General Education Electives of Hunan University*. Required general education courses are illustrated in the following table.
