

# 历史学

## 一、培养目标

本专业培养具有历史学的基本理论、专门知识和基本技能，具备良好的科学素养和创新能力，能继续深造或在国家机关、新闻出版、文化教育、文博档案及各类企业事业单位或领域从事研究、教学、管理等方面工作的历史学科复合型人才。

## 二、基本要求

本专业毕业生要求具备以下几方面的知识能力：

1. 历史学的基础知识、基本理论与方法。
2. 历史文献的检索与阅读能力。
3. 从事历史研究的初步能力。
4. 较强的文字与口头表达能力。
5. 较好的科学思维和创新能力。
6. 较高的人文素养。

## 三、培养特色

1. 培养全面发展的人才，不仅具有较好的专业素质，同时具备较好的思想素质和文化素质、健康的身体素质和心理素质。

2. 注重学生能力的提升，设计史学入门讲座、原始文献导读、中英文写作实训、历史资源调查、田野考察、学年论文撰写、导师全程指导等实践性课程与教学环节，能力培养贯串四年八个学期。

3. 弘扬中国古代书院教育传统，开发岳麓书院现有国学优势资源，课程设置以历史学为基础和主干，同时开设部分哲学、经学、考古与文博课程，促进文史哲融合。

## 四、学制、毕业基本要求及学位授予

1. 本科基本学制 4 年，弹性学习年限 3—6 年，按照学分制度管理。
2. 历史专业学生毕业最低学分数为 155 学分，其中各类别课程及环节要求学分数如下表：

# History

## I . Objectives

This program is designed for cultivating integrated talents in the discipline of history. Through this program, students will obtain basic theories, core knowledge and fundamental skills in historiography, as well as practical expertise and creativity. After graduation, they can go on study in this field or choose to start their career in government, press and publication, culture and education, museum, archive department or enterprises.

## II . Basic Specifications

The students are required to obtain knowledge and skills as following:

1. Basic Knowledge, theory and methodology in Historiography
2. Ability on searching and reading traditional Chinese documents
3. Basic ability on historical research
4. Enhanced ability on practical writing and speaking
5. Scientific thinking and creativity
6. Humanistic quality

## III . Characteristics

1. The program emphasizes professional quality, as well as ideological and cultural quality, and physical and mental health.

2. Focused on the development of students' ability, the carefully constructed curriculum is designed for four years, which includes introductory lecture of historiography, introductory reading of original documents, creative writing in Chinese and English, research of historic resources, field work, dissertation instructing and other practical courses.

3. Based on the prestige of Yuelu Academy's traditional culture, this program is devoted to providing courses in historiography, as well as offering inter-disciplinary courses, including Philosophy, Confucian Classics, Culture Relics and Museum, and Archaeology, and is trying to make all these different courses connected coherently.

## IV . Length of Schooling, Basic Requirements for Graduation and Degree Conferment

1. The length of schooling for undergraduate studies is four years, with a flexible length lasting from 3 to 6 years, based on the regulation of credit system.

2. Students of history majors are expected to complete a minimum of 155 credits upon graduation, and the required credits for different courses are illustrated in the following table.

3. On successful completion of the prescribed courses and intensive practice, students, who are qualified enough to meet all the requirements of this program, will thus be awarded the Bachelor's Degree of History.

(1) Students get third-class award or above when participating professional competition at home and abroad;

(2) Students publish academic papers in core professional journals or above.
